

<h2>Social Media Terms of Usage</h2>
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These Terms of Use govern the use of official accounts or pages operated by TechMatrix Corporation (hereinafter referred to as “the Company”) on social media (hereinafter referred to as “the Service”).

### **Article 1 (About These Terms)**

1. These Terms apply to the viewing and use of this Service. By using this Service, you are deemed to have agreed to these Terms.
2. The Company may modify these Terms without prior notice. The Company kindly asks that you review the latest version. The latest Terms shall take effect upon posting the revised Terms on our website.

### **Article 2 (Official Social Media Accounts)**

The Company’s official social media accounts can be found in the Official Social Media Accounts List.

### **Article 3 (Regarding Intellectual Property Rights)**

1. The copyright and all other intellectual property rights (including but not limited to copyrights, design rights, patent rights, utility model rights, trademark rights, and rights related to know-how) pertain to the information displayed on the Service belong to the Company or the respective rights holders.
2. By posting information or content to the Service, users grant the Company the right to use such content, on a worldwide, royalty-free, non-exclusive, sublicensable, and transferable basis, in any form (including reproduction, editing, modification, excerpting, public transmission, publication, translation, etc.). Users further agree not to assert or exercise any moral rights or similar rights in relation to such information or content against the Company.

  - ③ Acts that violate, or are likely to violate, applicable laws or regulations, or that are contrary to public order and good morals.
  - ④ Acts ordered to be deleted by government agencies or public institutions based on legal authority.
  - ⑤ Submitting false information when using the Service.
  - ⑥ Unauthorized use of email addresses, names, or other personal information belonging to other users, third parties, the Company, or partner companies
  - ⑦ Any use of the Service for business, profit-making, solicitation, expression of beliefs or ideologies, publicity, or preparatory activities for such purposes.
  - ⑧ Impersonating a third party, including the Company.
  - ⑨ Acts of linking in a manner that compromises the clarity of the content disseminated by the Service.
  - ⑩ Acts of advertising or promotional activities.
  - ⑪ Acts prohibited by companies operating social media platforms.
  - ⑫ Acts that violate the Public Offices Election Act.
  - ⑬ Acts that violate these Terms.
  - ⑭ Acts that interfere with the operation of the Service or are likely to impede its provision.
2. The Company may take measures, such as blocking the user's account or suspending the user's use of the Service, if we determine at our reasonable discretion that the user has violated the preceding paragraph.
3. If a user causes damage to the Company through acts described in Paragraph 1 of this Article or acts that violate these Terms of Service, the Company may demand compensation from such user for the damages incurred by the Company.

### **Article 5 (Privacy Policy)**

The Company handle users' personal information appropriately in accordance with our separately established Personal Information Protection Policy. For details, please refer to that policy.

### **Article 6 (Handling of Submitted Content)**

1. Comments (including reposts, replies, posts, etc.) that the Company determine violate the prohibited items stipulated in Article 4 may be hidden, deleted, rejected, or result in the blocking of the poster's account or other similar measures at the Company's discretion, without notice to the poster. The Company will not respond to inquiries regarding these measures.
2. The Company does not follow all users who follow the Service. Additionally, even if a user does not follow the Service, the Company may follow them.
3. The Company does not respond to all posts or comments made by users to us on the Service (including likes, reposts, etc.).

### **Article 7 (Service Changes and Discontinuation)**

The Company reserves the right to modify, add, suspend, or discontinue any content posted on this service without prior notice to users. Furthermore, we shall not be liable for any disadvantage or damage incurred by users as a result of such suspension or discontinuation.

### **Article 8 (Disclaimer)**

1. The Company exercises the utmost care when posting information on the Service; however, we make no guarantees whatsoever regarding the accuracy, currency, usefulness, or any other aspect of the posted information.
